Kankakee is staffed by 68 police officers, and 4 civilians. The Police Department is CALEA and ILEAP accredited with a dedicated and committed staff. The Police Chief is appointed by, and reports to, the Mayor.

Educational Requirements: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's Degree in Criminal Justice, law enforcement, public administration or related field - Master's Degree Preferred. Completion of a nationally recognized advanced law enforcement administration course is a plus.

Other Requirements: A minimum of ten (10+) years of progressively responsible command experience in a municipal or state police agency. Experience in working in a collective bargaining environment and experience with budget development are critical. A valid motor vehicle operator's license is required. Must have IL mandated firearms certification or qualifications to obtain upon hire. IL police officer certification or capable to obtain within a reasonable time-period.

A select number of finalist candidates will be invited to participate in an assessment center. A conditional offer of employment would be subject to a background investigation, physical, polygraph, and psychological examination.
